Balderdash is a ticketed event for visitors. They will be paying an admission fee that includes a wristband indicating 21+ and a tasting glass that will be used throughout the event. There is no fee for contestants entering the Cherry Bounce competition.

1. Bring a portable table, chair/chairs, and a pitcher to use for water to rinse out glasses. A pop up awning is also very helpful.
2. Set up for the event by 1:00. We have a farmers' market on site until 12:00. They have a different area to use on the property, but there will have to be some logistical accommodation made to get them out and the beer people in. We will make it work.
3. A minimum of three 750 ml bottles of the same recipe will need to be entered.
4. Don't give tastes to people without wristbands. They either didn't pay or are underage.
5. Don't give tastes to obviously intoxicated people. It is against the law.
6. Tastings start at 1:00 and finish at 5:00.
7. Have fun! Part of "marketing" your Bounce to the voting tasters is to put some thought into your table display and have a story about your Bounce (how it was made, how you named it, what your history is with making it, etc.)
